Kaospilots are people who can creatively lead a project through uncertainty and complexity. It is a person who cares more about creating meaningful change in an organization. As individuals, they possess crucial skills within project management, process leadership and business development, which make them masters at leading and driving a team forward in a project, especially during challenging and uncertain times.

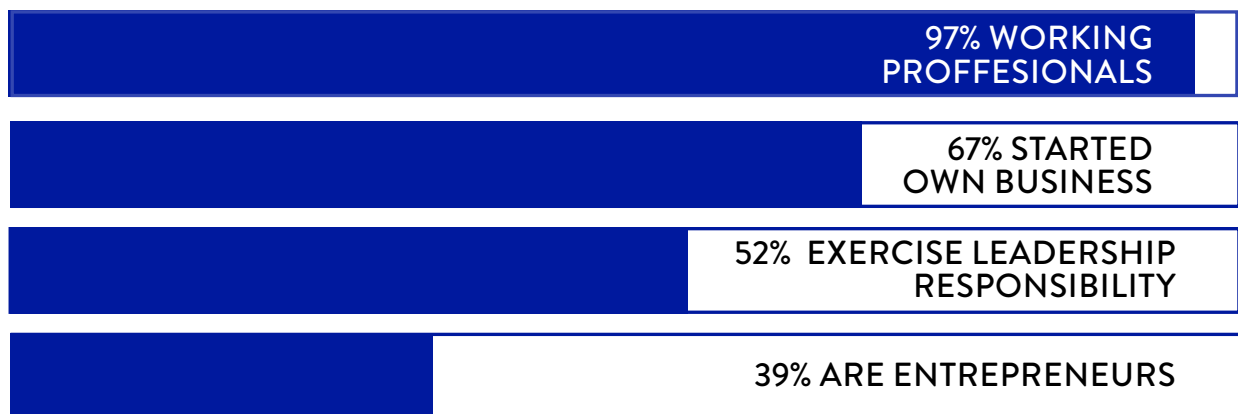
A Kaospilot is trained to work across disciplines and fields and is capable of combining and integrating widely varying knowledge sets, abilities and competencies.
