



Workshops & practice



Since I graduated I've worked with my fellow Team 18'er Rune Toldam in our company Bespoke. We co-founded Bespoke in 2013 as part of our third-year Pilot Project. At Bespoke we work in the intersection between future, strategy and design, helping organisations understand and make sense of the main forces shaping our world, and using that knowledge to imagine and design better futures for people, businesses and the planet.

In my job it's very important for me to realize that I need to learn something that I didn't know before. There is always something new to learn and someone new to meet. There is constant movement, constant development and constant

growth. Sometimes fast, sometimes slower, but always moving forward.

Curiosity goes a long way. Be curious about how other people think, how they live or what they love. Learn about how stuff works and how systems operate. If we want to change something, we need to understand it before proposing alternatives.

The world is more complicated than black and white. Don't live in absolutes. Contradictions can co-exist in our lives. Instead of judging others, be curious about them, and try to understand what motivates them.

Try everything. Don't be limited by your own conceptions of what you are not good at. Everything can be learned, and everything can be perfected. Keep on transforming yourself into something new. The only constant is change.
